## Monthly Book Review

## small great things by Jodi Picoult

Jodi Picoult is a born storyteller who "writes with a fine touch, a sharp eye for detail, and a firm grasp of delicacy and complexity of human relationships" (The Boston Globe). Her stunning novel, Small Great Things, is Picoult at her finest — complete with unflinching insights, richly layered characters, and a page-turning plot with a gripping moral dilemma at its heart. Ruth Jefferson is a labor and delivery nurse at a Connecticut hospital with more than twenty years' experience. During her shift, Ruth begins a routine checkup on a newborn, only to be told a few minutes later that she's been resigned to another patient. The parents are white supremacists and don't want Ruth, who is African American, to touch their child. The hospital complies with their request, but the next day, the baby goes into cardiac distress while Ruth is alone in the nursery. Does she obey orders or does she intervene? Ruth hesitates before CPR and, as a result, is charged with a with a serious crime.

## Healthy Aging With Joyce

From Joyce Hoffman, BA Social Work, Social Service Coordinator

Joyce is in her office here at the Center on Monday & Friday mornings from 9 to 12. Appointments at 860.564.1819 X 506 Free.

The Social Security Administration has announced a 2.8% COLA increase for 2026.

In 2026, the Medicare Part B Premium will go up to \$206.50 a month. This is up from \$185.00 a month in 2025. This premium will be deducted from your Social Security benefit each month **UNLESS** you are on the Medicare Savings Program with the State of CT.

Check with Joyce for the income guidelines for this program to see if you are eligible and keep more of your Social Security money each month

Did you know about 12 services that are FREE under Medicare?

- 1. A onetime "Welcome to Medicare" checkup in your first year on Medicare.
- 2. Wellness visit every year after that helps keep you healthy.
- 3. Vaccines that are meant to prevent severe illnesses such as shots for Shingles, RSV, Flu Shots, and COVID 19 shots.
- 4. Alcohol misuse screening each year
- 5. Eight counseling sessions in one year to help you stop smoking.
- 6. Diabetes screening.
- 7. Nutrition Therapy if you have Diabetes or kidney disease/kidney transplant.
- 8. Yearly Mammogram Screening
- 9. Colorectal cancer screening
- 10. Lung cancer screening
- 11. Prostrate cancer screening (Yearly PSA blood test and exam)
- 12. Depression screening once a year.

Talk with your Doctor about these FREE services and ask if you need any of them.
