FLOORS AND DECKS ARE SLIPPERY-Walk with caution.
UPON ENTERING POOL PLEASE READ RULES AND REPORT TO THE LIFEGUARD
TO SIGN-IN AND PAY FEE.

FOR YOUR SAFETY AND HEALTH PLEASE FOLLOW THESE RULES:

- *All patrons shall bathe with warm water and soap before entering the pool.
- *Any patron known or suspected of having a communicable disease, open sores or wounds shall not use the pool.
- *Spitting or blowing the nose in pool is prohibited.
- *Proper bathing suits must be worn- No cut-offs or T-shirts
- *Children in diapers must use a swim diaper and bathing suit.
- *No diving is permitted off the deck of the pool.
- *Use steps and ladders for getting in and out of the pool.
- *Jumping feet first is allowed between ladders in deep end only.
- *Long hair must be tied back or in a bathing cap.
- *Running, boisterous or rough play in the water, on the deck or in locker room is prohibited
- *Only Coast Guard approved flotation is allowed in the pool- An adult must be in the water with each child and children with flotation are restricted to the shallow end.
- *No food or glass containers allowed in pool area or locker rooms.
- *Do not leave valuables in the locker room. Any lock used must be removed daily.
- *Children age 12 and up are welcome to use the pool independently. Those under the age of 12 must be accompanied by an adult and pass the swimming test to have access to the deep end. Children who do not pass the swim test must remain on the shallow end including those in lifejackets.
